Adam Sandt



Adam's 11-year BML career started with one season with Krock's Diamondbacks prior to him joining the Orioles in 2006. With the Orioles, he became one of the best all-around players of his era. He compiled .383 lifetime batting average to go along with his 1.117 OPS. During this time, he won an unprecedented three consecutive league MVP awards and was four time All-League shortstop.

Adam won the BML Triple Crown in 2012, the first player to accomplish this feat since 1965. While Adam's offensive and defensive abilities were truly remarkable, it was his pure love of the game that was most impressive. That is what enabled Adam to become the accomplished player that he was.

Jay Rothenhausler



Jay played 22 seasons in the Blue Mountain League. After short stints with the Easton Tigers and Bicentennial Stars, he was picked up by Martin's Creek where he'd play for 10 seasons and win a league championship. He played 5 years with the newly formed Bethlehem Cardinals before going to the Hellertown Royals, where he finished his career with 3 championship wins.

Jay had a .328 lifetime batting average. He was a 12-time All-Star, was named All-League catcher 5 times, and he was consistently in the top 10 for RBI. While he played multiple positions, he was primarily a catcher known for his strong arm, impressive ability to block the ball, and his power hitting.

HALL OF FAME SELECTION PROCESS

Many times we are asked how we go about selecting the inductees to the Blue Mountain League Hall of Fame. First, we have set up rules and guidelines. They state:

"To be considered for selection, a nominee must have made an outstanding contribution to the BML as a player, coach, manager, umpire, league official or team official."

"All nominees shall have participated in the BML in some manner for a period of not less than five (5) years."

"A nominee may be selected for his contribution in one category even though he is still active in the League in another category. Players, to be selected, must be inactive as a player for at least five (5) years. Coaches, managers, league officials umpires and team officials may be selected while still active in the BML, provided they have participated in the League for at least ten (10) years."

Next, we set a limit on how many nominees we feel are appropriate to induct. We want to be sure to induct all those who are worthy, but on the other hand, we do not wish to induct too many in any given year.

Nominations are then solicited from the Committee, the League and the general public. Nominations are welcome at any time, and they are kept on file for at least five years. Every year, we receive more and more nominations to add to those we have received in the past.

Finally, every nominee's record of contributions is carefully researched and discussed. The merits of each nominee is debated. Then, and only then, does the committee make its selections.






